

Optum Contracted Office Based Opioid Treatment Program Providers: What you need to know about the 2020 CPT® code changes

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) announced that there are three additional HCPCS codes that may be billed by Office Based Opioid Treatment (OBOT) Program Providers for *Medicare* members beginning on January 1, 2020. Here are the specific codes:

G2086	Office-based treatment for opioid use disorder, including development of the treatment plan, care coordination, individual therapy and group therapy and counseling; at least 70 minutes in the first calendar month.
G2087	Office-based treatment for opioid use disorder, including care coordination, individual therapy and group therapy and counseling; at least 60 minutes in a subsequent calendar month
G2088	Office-based treatment for opioid use disorder, including care coordination, individual therapy and group therapy and counseling; each additional 30 minutes beyond the first 120 minutes (List separately in addition to code for primary procedure).

If you are a provider serving *Medicare* members, who is currently contracted with Optum to bill for OBOT Program Services, you may begin using the updated code set once your Provider Agreement has been updated with the Amendment related to this change. For these new HCPCS codes, you will be reimbursed at the rates set forth in the Amendment.

Please inform your billing departments as soon as possible of these changes to ensure that all staff and systems are aware that they may submit the additional HCPCS codes once the Amendment has been completed.
